



NWT Apprenticeship - Trade Entrance Requirements

Applicants must satisfy the following entry requirements with option 1, 2 or 3 before signing an Apprenticeship contract. The GNWT encourages all students to complete the high school graduation requirements.

Note: High school transcripts showing the approved course credits obtained must be within the past 10 years.

Option 3 (for any Category): Pass all five Canadian General Development (GED) tests.

University Entrance Requirements

All University Programs need ELA 30-1 and at least 4 additional 30 Level Courses.

Examples:

Bachelor of Science: ELA 30-1, Math 30-1, Two Sciences (Chem, Bio, Physics), One additional (Third Science, Calculus, Social 30-1, FLA 30, FRE 30, ART 30, etc)

Bachelor of Arts: ELA 30-1, Math 30-2, Social 30-1, FRENCH 30, Biology 30

Bach. Sci/Engineering: ELA 30-1, Math 30-1, Math 31, Physics 30, Chem 30

Bach. Sci/Nursing: ELA 30-1, Math 30-1/-2, Bio 30, Chem 30, One Additional
